Jammu and Kashmir declares Jerri Hamlet as the first milk village

Jammu and Kashmir administration has declared Jerri Hamlet in the Reasi district as the first 'milk village' of Jammu and Kashmir and sanctioned 57 more dairy farms under the Integrated Dairy Development Scheme (IDDS) for this hamlet.

This milk village houses 73 individual dairy units with 370 cows, which will give financial security to the local farmers.

Under the IDDS, dairy units of five animals are provided with a 50 per cent subsidy.

This scheme also has a provision for milking machine, bulk milk cooling unit at 50 per cent subsidy (maximum subsidy of ₹5 lakhs), paneer making machine, khoya making, Dahi making, cream separator, ice cream making machine, butter and ghee making machine (maximum subsidy of ₹3.5 lakhs), milk van (maximum subsidy of ₹2 lakhs and milk ATM subsidy of ₹5 lakhs). Appointments






