Patna administration identifies all 96 UK returnees

Patna: Patna district administration Thursday identified all the people who had returned to the state capital from United Kingdom (UK) from November 21 to December 21.

"On Thursday, we could finally trace the 96 people who had arrived Patna from UK recently. Many have moved to other states and even returned to UK. The district administration officials of the states where they have migrated to have been informed and the district magistrates asked to administer them tests. Besides, testing of those who are in Patna is being done," said Patna civil surgeon Dr Vibha Kumari Singh. She, however, did not disclose the states to which the people had migrated on the grounds
